
THE STATE OF THE IT NATION




73% don't monitor their whole IT estate


58% can't view their entire estate via a single pane of glass

53% fail to automate IT monitoring and OPS which supports business agility


These issues cause problems like tool sprawl, IT siloes and a lack of clarity
